- We have reviewed the accompanying Statement of unaudited financial Results of BOB Financial Solutions Limited ('the Company') for the quarter and half year ended 30th September 2023 ("the Statement"), being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirements of Regulation 52 read with Regulation 63(2) of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (Listing Regulations), as amended.
- 2. - 3) Information as required by Regulation 52(4) of SEBI(Listing obligation and Disclosure Requirements) Regulation 2015 is as per Annexure "1" attached.
- 4) Previous period's/ year's figure have been regrouped / reclassified wherever necessary to correspond with the current period's/ year's classification/ disclosure.
- 5) Management has exercised necessary due diligence to ensure that the said comparative results provide a true and fair view of its affairs.
- 6) The Management has reviewed and reconsidered the requirements of presenting segment information and accordingly identified Business segment as the Primary segment for disclosure for the current year. The Company operations are in India and hence there is segment reporting by geographical segment. Segment Information has been prepared in conformity with the Ind AS 108 on segment reporting as per Annexure "2" attached.
- 7) During the quarter ended 30th June 2023, Company has calibrated its existing ECL model and adopted new approach to calculate probability of default (PD) based on slippage of number of accounts instead of slippage of amount in line with the general industry practice. Accordingly, there is a reversal of ECL provision to the tune of Rs 60.30 mn in June 2023 quarter.
- 8) Figures of the last quarter in each of the financial years are the balancing figures between audited figures in respect of the full financial year and the published year-to-date figures upto the end of third quarter of respective financial year.
